The European Master in Management invests in tomorrow's entrepreneurial leaders

To help students finance their European Master in Management, we provide eligible participants with financial aid. These scholarships are limited in number and are granted based on criteria matching the European Master in Management programme's mission and values.

The European Master in Management promotes the values of entrepreneurial leadership, respect of ethical and social responsibility. It strives to offer all students a diverse and international learning environment.

Applying for a Scholarship

To apply for a scholarship, you will need to submit a financial aid request form. Contact the International Student Recruitment or the admissions department to obtain one. The financial aid request process runs alongside the application and admissions process, and applications for financial aid are taken into account only after the applicant has been admitted into the programme.

Scholarships are granted on a yearly basis. Renewal of the scholarship offer for a subsequent study year is contingent on the student's academic performance in its first year.

Scholarships available

➤ Excellence Scholarship

The European Master in Management rewards outstanding candidates with the Excellence Scholarship. Excellence is determined based on various criteria such as the applicant's GMAT score, academic results and professional achievements. Up to 35% of the tuition fee can be waived for incumbents.

➤ Merit Scholarship

Personal and financial concerns should not prevent high potential and motivated candidates from pursuing a world class graduate programme. To help these applicants, up to 30% of the tuition fees can be waived for incumbents.

➤ Diversity Scholarship

To ensure a rich learning environment, the European Master in Management encourages diversity in terms of background, industry and nationality for its student body. Up to 30% of the tuition fees can be waived for incumbents.

Additional ways to finance your European Master in Management programme

■ The French, German and British embassies

You may contact the French, German and British embassies in your country which may offer individual scholarships for students who want to pursue their studies in France, Germany or the UK.

■ The Rhône-Alpes region scholarship for studying abroad

Explo'ra Sup is a financial aid programme from the Rhône-Alpes region which can be granted to students from the European Master in Management who spend their second year in Germany or England (95 €/week).

■ Your home country's financial aids

Your home country is very likely to have a system to help finance your studies abroad.

■ Bank loans in France

To apply for a bank loan in France, international students will be required to have a French resident as a guarantor. EMLYON has partnerships with two banks which grant student loans at advantageous conditions.
